Dear Parents/Carers,

This Thursday 17 August at 7.00 pm our Years 3 - 6 students will be presenting the musical 'Dragon Days' in our school hall.

A dress rehearsal will take place **TOMORROW Wednesday 16 August at 12 noon**. Grandparents, family friends and parents of toddlers who cannot make it on the night are welcome to come along to this performance if they wish.

Please read the following information regarding organisation of this production.

Each child is asked to bring the following items to school for the dress rehearsal on Wednesday 16 August and for the performance on Thursday 17th August:

- ✓ blue jeans (or blue school pants) – *please leave at school overnight*
- ✓ white school sneakers
- ✓ white socks
- The students will wear special T-shirts which belong to the school for the performance.
- The show has an alpine theme so girls may wear their hair in plaits/braids if they wish.

Thursday night:

- Students should arrive at school **at 6.30 pm** (please not before) and go directly to their classrooms where their teachers will assume duty of care for them. (Please note there is a separate arrangement for the children in 4B who are having their faces painted.)
- Students should wear comfortable, easy to change clothes to school.
- After taking their children to the classrooms, parents are asked to go directly into the hall using the external doors from the Kinder/Year 1 playground. **No guests will be permitted into the hall before 6.30 pm.**
- Please do not **save** seats in the front four rows for guests who are coming later as these seats are highly prized and must be shared fairly.
- A gold coin donation at the door to cover costs would be appreciated.
- The performance starts at 7.00 pm and should end by approximately 8.20 pm.
- If you wish to take photos or videos during the show please do so from the **BACK** of the Hall.
- When the show is finished, the children will exit the Hall and go directly to their classrooms to collect their clothes.
- Parents will then be invited to collect their children from their classrooms.
